- Meet with children who have witnessed violence in the home.
- * Provide groups for children.
- Provide individual counselling for children.



- Children may feel confused, scared or blame themselves
- * Children may be injured if they try to referee or rescue mom
- * Children may blame mom for abuse.
- Children may become angry and aggressive or the opposite, they may become sad and withdrawn.
- Children may refuse to respect mom's authority.



We can help. We have groups for children.

In group children will:

- * Work on making their own safety plan.
- * Learn to express their feelings safely.
- * Discuss their feelings of guilt, shame or loss.
- Practice problem solving.
- * Take part in exercises that will build their self-esteem.
- * Have fun

Mothers can participate in a separate group at the same time as the children.
