## Family Court Support Program

### A Family Court Support Worker offers:

- \* Support for women who have experienced domestic violence and are involved in the family court process.
- \* Information about the family court process.
- \* Assistance through the Legal Aid process.
- \* Referrals to specialized services in the community.
- \* To accompany women to court proceedings where appropriate.



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## Children's Services

### Children's Service - In Shelter

#### A Children's Service Worker will:

- \* Be available for children that come to stay at the shelter with mom.
- \* Advocate and support mom while staying in the shelter.
- \* Make referrals for mom regarding children's services in community.
- \* Organize off-site activities for kids staying in shelter.
- \* Organize on-site activities such as movie nights and crafts.



### The Children's Outreach Worker

#### will:

- \* Meet with children who have witnessed violence in the home.
- \* Provide groups for children.
- \* Provide individual counselling for children.

## Outreach Services

### An Outreach Counsellor will:

- \* Provide individual counselling.
- \* Provide group counselling.
- \* Help with safety planning.
- \* Make referrals and offer advocacy.
- \* Provide support groups for women.
- \* Provide assistance with finding safe, affordable and sustainable housing.
- \* Give assistance with legal issues.
